Shifting landscape for regional markets and RPS's



Angela Cifor, J.D., is an attorney and Research Associate with RASEI's Law & Policy Group with expertise in domestic and international energy, environmental, and resource law. Her research focuses on the legal, regulatory, economic, and public policy facets of energy development. At present, she is examining grid integration of renewable energy, the increasing role of natural gas in the electricity sector, demand response as an ancillary service, and energy access for the Least Developed Countries. Her past research topics include carbon capture, utilization and sequestration and associated mineral ownership issues; smart grid challenges and opportunities; pumped hydro and ancillary services; and the history of electricity market development in the Western Interconnection, among others.

Angela joined RASEI as a Research Assistant in 2010 and later as a full-time Research Associate after graduating from the University of Colorado Law School in 2012. Prior to this appointment, Angela was a Policy Analyst at the University of Colorado Law School's Center for Energy and Environmental Security.
