Barb Goodman, NREL



Ms. Barbara Goodman is NREL's Associate Laboratory Director overseeing the National Wind Technology Center (NWTC) and Commercial Building Efficiency. Ms. Goodman served as director of transportation technologies & systems research and development from 1996 to 2012. In this position she was responsible for NREL's research in advanced vehicles and fuels including evaluating advanced battery technologies and power electronics; measuring emissions; reducing energy requirements associated with heating and cooling vehicles; evaluating effectiveness of advanced fuels in current and future engines; and evaluating air quality impacts. In her 28-year career at NREL, Ms. Goodman has been a staff engineer and program manager for the ethanol, municipal solid waste, and alternative fuels programs. Ms. Goodman began her career teaching anthropology at the Community College of Denver and math at the Colorado School of Mines. She has a Bachelor of Science degree in chemical and petroleum refining engineering from the Colorado School of Mines.
