In this role, she focuses on economic assessment and development of transmission, supporting MISO's overall goal of developing a comprehensive expansion plan to meet policy, economic and reliability needs utilizing capacity expansion tools and production cost tools. Previously, Ms. Hecker was responsible for developing the economic analysis for MISO's Multi Value Project (MVP) portfolio, managing the MTEP long-range transmission planning effort and market efficiency planning studies, and leading the economic transmission design and wind integration analysis for the Eastern Wind Integration and Transmission Study (EWITS). She holds a Doctor of Philosophy degree in Electrical Engineering from University of Missouri - Rolla.
